

## Consequences of a study break (approved leave)

Prior to apply for a study break (approved leave from studies) it is recommended that the student meets with the study counsellor of his/her degree programme, since the student must be aware of the consequences a study break result in (please see below).

The consequences of a study break are as follows:

- Jönköping University informs the Swedish Migration Agency that the student has been granted a study break. The Swedish Migration Agency will revoke the student's residence permit and consequently the student must leave Sweden.
- The student is not allowed to keep his/her student accommodation, if on a study break.
- The planning of future studies may also be affected, seeing as changes of programmes and cancellation of courses may occur during the student's absence.
- Insurance for Tuition-Fee-Paying Students is no longer valid.
  It applies during the education period in accordance with the LADOK system which means that the student needs to be active and registered to a course in order to be covered by the insurance.
